### INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) (Journal of Laws UE L 119 of 04/05/2016, page 1, as amended), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", I would like to inform you about the principles of processing your personal data and about your related rights.

4. Your personal data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the objectives as stated above, and after that time for the period and to the extent specified by law, in accordance with the office instructions.
5. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country.
6. The recipients of your personal data will be persons authorized by the Administrator and entities processing personal data on behalf of the Administrator.

8. You have the right to request the Administrator to access your personal data, rectify it, delete it and limit data processing.
