



PAPER ON SKIN™ 2024 – CALL FOR ENTRIES

The prestigious Paper on Skin™ wearable paper art competition is now open for entries.

Paper on Skin™ invites artists and designers to embrace the challenge of designing a wearable garment made from at least 80% paper.

A biennial event, 2024 will mark the 7th iteration of Paper on Skin™.

The event is held in Devonport, Tasmania, and draws on the industrial history of papermaking in the region.

This year there are a total of ten awards, with a prize pool over AUD\$14 000.

The awards will be announced at a gala event and theatrical parade on September 21st, 2024.

All finalists' works will be exhibited at the Devonport Regional Gallery from Sept 28 - Nov 16.

Entries close 16th February, 2024. Entry Fee AUD\$55.

Two-stage selection process. Finalists announced after Round Two – 26th April, 2024.

Paper on Skin™ is open to international entrants.

Paper on Skin™ is presented in partnership with the Devonport City Council, with assistance from the Tasmanian Government and North West Support Services.

All works will be professionally photographed and a suite of films will be produced.
