Korea Bojagi Forum 2020 Call for Bojagi Inspired Art

Exhibition Dates May 13 - 19, 2020, Seoul, South Korea

The Korea Bojagi Forum (KBF) is a biennial conference brings together artists, textile lovers, and scholars from around the world to celebrate the Korean tradition of the wrapping cloth as a continuing source of inspiration for contemporary fiber art.

KBF is accepting entries for the 2020 Korea Bojagi Forum international juried exhibition. Approaching its 10th anniversary, KBF seeks to showcase a wide range of outstanding bojagi inspired works in fiber or mixed media. We seek reinterpretations of this traditional art form that test its boundaries and go beyond. Accepted entries will be featured in the Forum exhibitions and documented in a full-color catalog.

This exhibition is open to all artists 18 years and over working in the field of fiber art. All work submitted must be original, completed in the last three years and not previously exhibited in the KBF exhibitions.

Work Categories: Works are sought for the following three categories: Interior or Exterior Non wearable works, Bojagi Inspired Wearables inspired by Korean traditional costume (Hanbok), and Bojagi Inspired Miniatures .

Size restrictions: are as follows: **Non-wearable:** maximum of 35 "(approx. 90cm) in width and maximum length of 51 " (approx. 130cm) or longer. **Wearable:** life-size. **Miniature:** 20 cm x 20 cm.

Submission fee: \$US 50 for first entry. Additional entries \$25 each.

Image requirements: JPEG format 300 ppi, 1500 pixels wide.

File name: Label images :lastname_firstname_nameofwork.jpeg -- spelled out in full.

Selected artists will pay a an additional participation fee. All selected artworks will be featured in the full-color catalog produced by KBF. Exhibiting artists will receive a copy of the 2020 KBF catalog. Others may purchase the catalog at \$40.00 per copy plus shipping (approx. 20\$).
